Winter Coat program is under way. If you are able to donate coats, hats, gloves, etc. please bring on Sunday or contact Kathleen Demers.

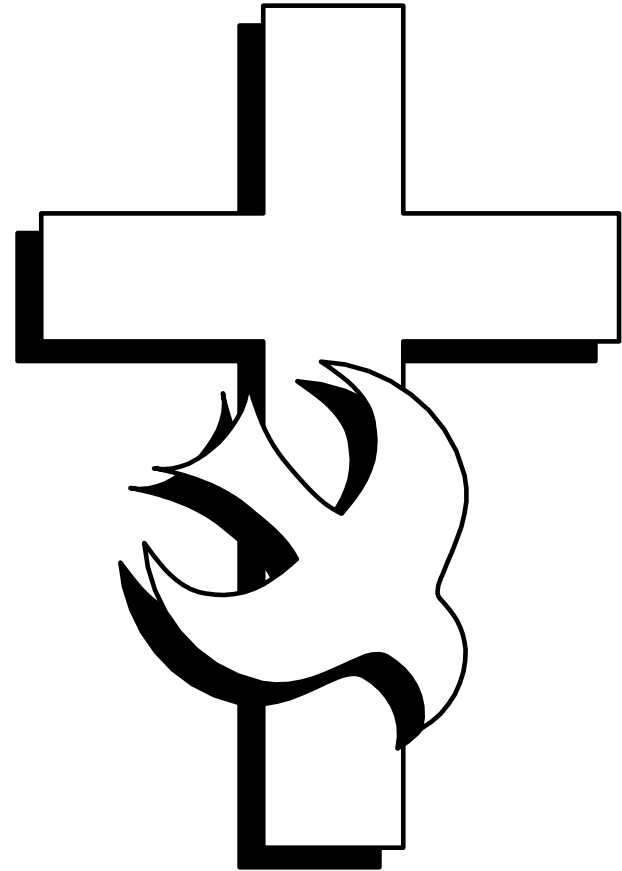
